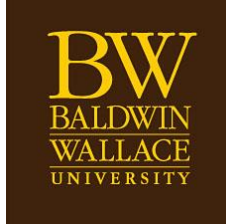

Description: NOT your typical professional development...A collaboration between **Baldwin Wallace University** and **Cleveland Clinic Civic Education!** No final paper required, separate log or workshop/classes to attend. Instead, participating teachers will submit evolving, individualized eXpressions® lesson plans and strategies on a format to be given once registered.

***** Note:** While you can participate in eXpressions® without applying for BW credit, you cannot receive BW credit without participating in eXpressions®.

- All teachers applying for credit will submit formatted **lePs (Individualized eXpressions® Plans)** whether for one or two hours to: ancole@bw.edu This is an individualized program with hours varying by school, number of students and complexity of projects. Work with students in your classrooms on your own timeline, extending their learning while documenting your plans and strategies. This is not theory, this is practice! This PD should meet all criteria for RESA, OTES and IPDP.
- **One credit hour:** The final product/assessment will be *submission* of student projects to **eXpressions®** for evaluation and publication. The process is key.
- **Two credit hours:** Teachers will submit and then have additional hours involved in planning for community/school-based displays (digital or live presentations) of their submissions *and/or* will serve as eXpressions® Teacher Mentors.
- **Note:** *Acceptance* of student work for the competitive, curated and published **eXpressions®** exhibition is not required for either BW credit or participation. *Submission alone*, with accompanying requirements met, is sufficient for credit.
- Additionally, all teachers applying for BW credit will be mentored by Anne Cole to collect and assess plans/data, provide support (including in-building as needed), serve as a liaison with BW and CC and make sure that all criteria are met. Participants will receive an S or U at the end of the fall semester.
- **Once registered any time before October 19th.**, Anne Cole will email teachers **leP** templates and syllabus.
- **September - November:** Teachers will work with students on their research interpretations, including student pre- and post-assessments.
- **By November 8th:** Teachers will have students submit their work following all criteria for submission.
- **December 7th:** Teachers will have completed **eX** requirements.
- **February, 2018:** Teachers will be encouraged to attend the **eXpressions® Opening Reception** (Invitations to follow)

All participation data gathered from CC will be shared by Anne Cole with BW's School of Education.
